RE: ENDORSING THE LAFAYETTE BOULEVARD CORRIDOR STUDY FINDINGS, VISION AND IMPROVEMENT CONCEPTS

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Boulevard Corridor is a key transportation, residential, and commercial zone linking Spotsylvania County and the City of Fredericksburg; and

WHEREAS, this corridor suffers from pedestrian safety problems, traffic congestion, inefficient infrastructure and under-development; and

WHEREAS, the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (FAMPO) has undertaken a comprehensive, multimodal study of the corridor over the past eighteen months; and


