FAMPO RESOLUTION 22-05

AUTHORIZING STAFF TO ISSUE NOTICES OF INTENT TO AWARD ON-CALL PROFESSIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLANNING SERVICES CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the Policy Committee directed staff to issue a request for proposals to solicit new on-call professional transportation planning services in the Fiscal Years 2021 and 2022 Unified Planning Work Programs; and

WHEREAS, the Policy Committee approved FAMPO RFP No. 001/2021 on April 19, 2021 thereby authorizing staff to proceed with the procurement; and

WHEREAS, staff, in coordination with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), George Washington Regional Commission (GWRC), and legal counsel, have conducted a procurement process in accordance with the GWRC Procurement Policy (revised October 21, 2019) and the Virginia Public Procurement Act (VPPA); and

WHEREAS, five proposals were received, all of which were responsive and technically acceptable; and


WHEREAS, staff reviewed, evaluated, and ranked proposals, conducted interviews with the four top-ranked firms based on initial evaluation, and completed final evaluations in coordination with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT), and the FAMPO Technical Advisory Committee Chairman; and

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed this information in closed session with the Policy Committee and recommends Cambridge Systematics, Michael Baker, and VHB for selection as new on-call consultants for a base period of three years with two one-year options.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Committee hereby authorizes staff to issue a Notice of Intent to Award (NIA) to Cambridge Systematics, Michael Baker, and VHB.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, barring any breakdown in negotiations with prospective consultants, the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Committee hereby recommends to the George Washington Regional Commission that it authorize its Interim Executive Director to execute an on-call contract with Cambridge Systematics, Michael Baker, and VHB.
