FAMPO RESOLUTION 23-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE FREDERICKSBURG AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION SUPPORTING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE OFFICE OF THE U.S. SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE SAFE STREETS FOR ALL (SS4A) GRANT TO DEVELOP A SAFETY ACTION PLAN FOR GEORGE WASHINGTON REGIONAL COMMISSION LOCALITIES

WHEREAS, a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO), Assistance Listing #20.939, invites MPO's and Planning District Commissions to apply for funding in alignment with the priorities in Executive Order 14052, Implementation of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (86 FR 64355); and

WHEREAS, NOFO #20.939 is the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Discretionary Grant Opportunity; and

WHEREAS, the SS4A Grant funds are awarded on a competitive basis to support planning, infrastructure, behavioral, and operational initiatives to prevent death and serious injury on roads and streets involving all roadway users, including pedestrians; bicyclists; public transportation, personal conveyance, and micromobility users; motorists; and commercial vehicle operators; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of public safety and benefit for a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan to be developed for the Counties of Caroline, King George, Stafford and Spotsylvania and the City of Fredericksburg (GWRC localities); and

WHEREAS, VDOT's Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) office is conducting crash analysis and equity analysis for the GWRC localities to be completed in summer of 2023; and

WHEREAS, VDOT's analyses can be used for the SS4A Grant and for independent HSIP project allocations; and

WHEREAS, FAMPO staff and the FAMPO Technical Advisory Committee recommend filing an application for a Safety Action Plan with VDOT's analyses used as a valuable contribution of required plan elements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization supports the filing of an SS4A grant application by GWRC by the September 15, 2022 deadline.
