FAMPO RESOLUTION 24-13

Approving a Rollover from the FY21-24 Transportation Improvement Program to the FY24-27 Transportation Improvement Program for 2 Projects: Route 1 and Exit 126 Southbound Improvements; #SMART 22 - I95 Exit 126 STARS Study Improvements

WHEREAS, the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (FAMPO) has a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Fiscal Years 2021-2024 which was adopted on October 1, 2020, and amended January 25, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (FAMPO) has a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Fiscal Years 2024-2027 which was adopted on June 26, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Transportation has rolled over FY21-24 funds to the FY24-27 TIP for 2 Projects: UPC 121802 Route 1 and Exit 126 Southbound Improvements and UPC 119112 #SMART 22 - I95 Exit 126 STARS Study Improvements; and


WHEREAS, the FAMPO Policy Committee wishes to modify the FY24-27 TIP to reflect the rollover funding for this project; and
